James 1:19-27

- 19. My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry,
- 20. because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.
- 21. Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you.
- 22. Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.
- 23. Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror

- 27. Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.
