

THE SCRIPTURE READING St. Matthew 28:1-10

- After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb.
- 2. There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it.
- 3. His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow.
- 4. The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men.
- 5. The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified.
- 6. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay.

- 8. So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples.
- 9. Suddenly Jesus met them. "Greetings," he said. They came to him, clasped his feet and worshiped him.
- 10. Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me."

Acts 2:22-24, 36-38

- 22. "Fellow Israelites, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know.
- 23. This man was handed over to you by God's deliberate plan and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross.
- 24. But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him.
